A. Subject Matter

Upon completion of this course, the student will:

1. Assess an emergency situation and activate the Emergency Medical System.
2. Provide first response treatment in most medical emergencies.
3. Assist in providing emergency treatment and aiding the sick or injured.
4. Perform cardiopulmonary resuscitation in an emergency situation.

Analytical Skills

Critical Thinking Skills: Students will use critical thinking skills to identify health and safety problems/issues and develop solutions/analysis. Students will identify health problems or safety issues within First Aid scenarios. Students will generate solutions/analysis of health problems and safety issues evaluated. Students will assess and justify viable solutions and/or analysis when presented with a First Aid scenario.

Ethical Decision Making

Students will model ethical decision-making processes. Students will identify ethical dilemmas and affected parties in the care of patients. Students will

apply ethical frameworks to resolve ethical dilemmas in First Aid scenarios and patient care situations
