Carl Albert State College (CASC) students interested in earning a Bachelor of Science in Criminal Justice (BSCJ) degree from the University of Arkansas (UAFS) may complete the first two years (lower division coursework) of the bachelor degree requirements at CASC by completing an Associate of Arts degree in Criminal Justice. Completed CASC courses will be accepted by UAFS and applied to the BSCJ degree requirements according to the UAFS Undergraduate Academic Catalog. CJ major courses completed at CASC will count toward the UAFS residency requirements for conferral of the degree. UAFS will offer the remaining BSCJ degree requirements through online courses or on the UAFS campus.

Student Degree Program Requirements
