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Motlow State Community College (MSCC) students interested in earning a Bachelor of Science in Organizational Leadership (BSOL) degree from the University of Arkansas – Fort Smith (UAFS) may complete the first two years (lower division coursework) of the bachelor's degree requirements at MSCC by completing an Associate of Arts, Associate of Science, and Associate of General Studies degrees in programs approved by MSCC. Completed MSCC courses will be accepted by UAFS and applied to the BSOL degree requirements according to the UAFS Undergraduate Academic Catalog. UAFS will offer the remaining BSOL degree requirements through online courses. Per the partnership agreement, UAFS will transfer up to 75 hours of lower division coursework for the BSOL.
