MATH 1123 College Algebra is used as an elective if taken as a prerequisite for BUS 2213; SOCI 1103 will also count as elective towards the UAFS degree requirements. Must have a total of 12 elective hours.
- 4. Required Business Computing Competency may be fulfilled by successful completion of CIS 1013 Information Systems.
- 5. Major Electives, 24 hours. Must be upper-level courses within the College of Business. See catalog for requirements.
- 6. Prior to graduation students must demonstrate competency in financial literacy by satisfactory completion of FIN 1521 Personal Finance Applications (or an approved substitution) with a grade of C or better, or by a score of 70% or more on a challenge exam for FIN 1521.
