University of Arkansas Community College at Batesville (UACCB) students interested in earning a Bachelor of Business Administration (BBA) majoring in Business Administration from the University of Arkansas – Fort Smith (UAFS) may complete the first two years (lower division coursework) of the bachelor's degree requirements at UACCB by completing a Business Associate of Science from UACCB. Completed UACCB courses will be accepted by UAFS and applied to the BBA requirements according to the UAFS Undergraduate Academic Catalog. UAFS will offer the remaining requirements through the BBA - Online Completion Degree Option. Students interested in concentrations in Accounting, Finance, International Business, and Marketing will need to complete upper-level major requirements on the UAFS campus.
