University of Arkansas - Pulaski Tech College (UAPTC) students interested in earning a Bachelor of Business Administration (BBA) degree from the University of Arkansas – Fort Smith (UAFS) may complete the first two years (lower division coursework) of the bachelor's degree requirements at UAPTC by completing an Associate of Science in Business Administration. Completed UAPTC courses will be accepted by UAFS and applied to the BBA requirements according to the UAFS Undergraduate Academic Catalog. UAFS will offer the remaining requirements through classes offered on campus or online. Students completing requirements on campus may choose from among several different concentrations. An online option is available.

2. These courses are used to determine major GPA, see Graduation Requirements section of the UAFS Undergraduate Academic Catalog.			
3. Electives, 12 hours, select courses that will satisfy degree requirements for baccalaureate program. UAPTC MATH 11003 College Algebra and MATH 10843 Business Calculus will count for 6 hours, and BUSI 14803 will count for 3 hours. Select additional elective hours with advisor.			
4. These courses require completion of MATH 21003, BUSI 20103, all lower-level business core courses (except ACCT 20103, required business computing competency, and cumulative GPA of 2.5 (transfer work may be considered)).			
5. Major Requirements, 24 hours. Must be upper-level courses within the College of Business. See catalog for requirements.			
6. Prior to graduation students must demonstrate competency in financial literacy by satisfactory completion of FINN 15201 Personal Finance Applications (or an approved substitution) with a grade of C or better, or by a score of 70% or more on a challenge exam for FINN 15201.

Student Degree Program Requirements

A student's degree program requirements are those specified in the catalog in effect at the time of declaration of program major. The program can be changed only with the approval of the official advisor. If original courses are eliminated, students may be required to meet new curriculum requirements in the degree program. If students are not enrolled for two or more consecutive terms (excluding summer terms), they must reenter under the program requirements of the current catalog.
