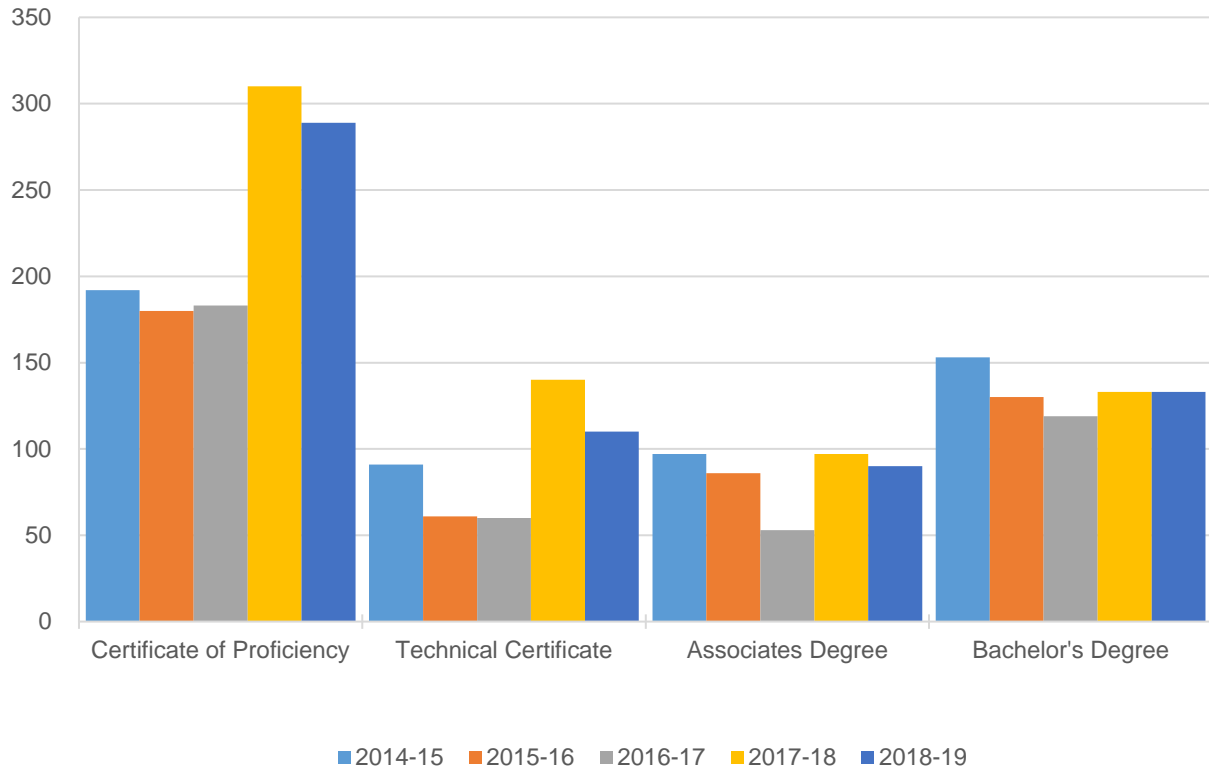

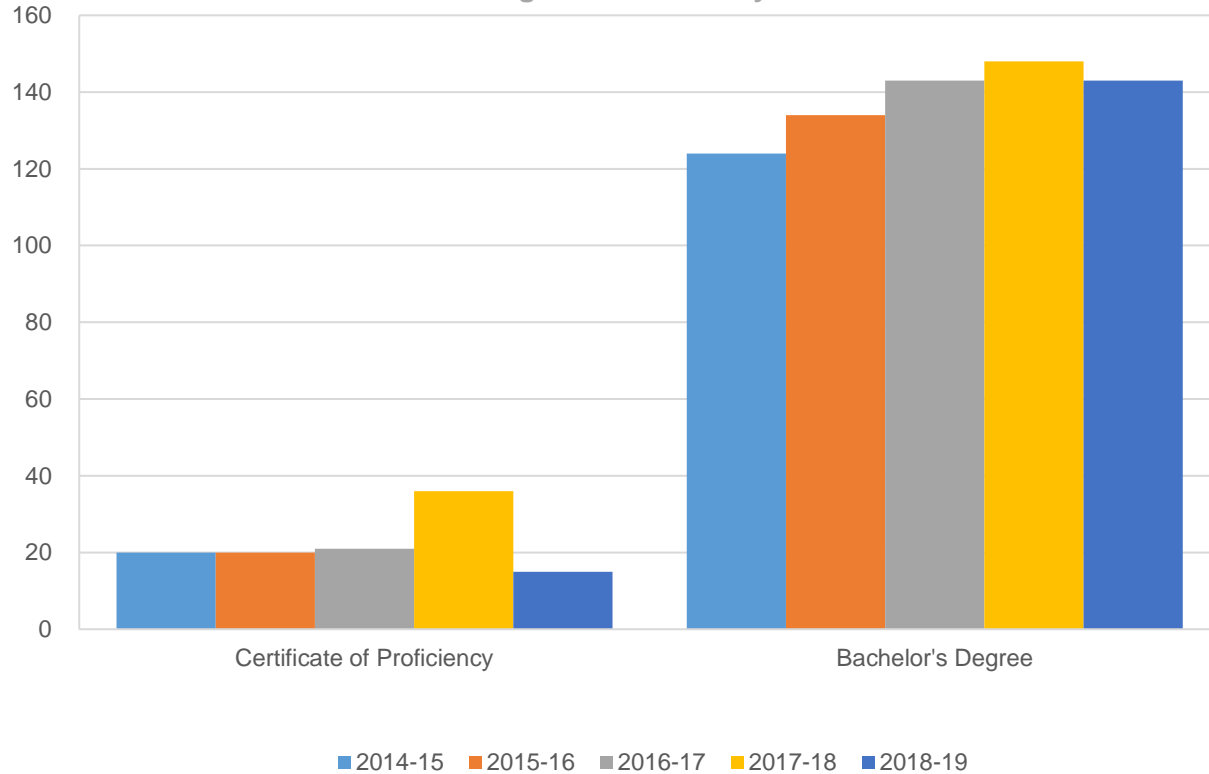

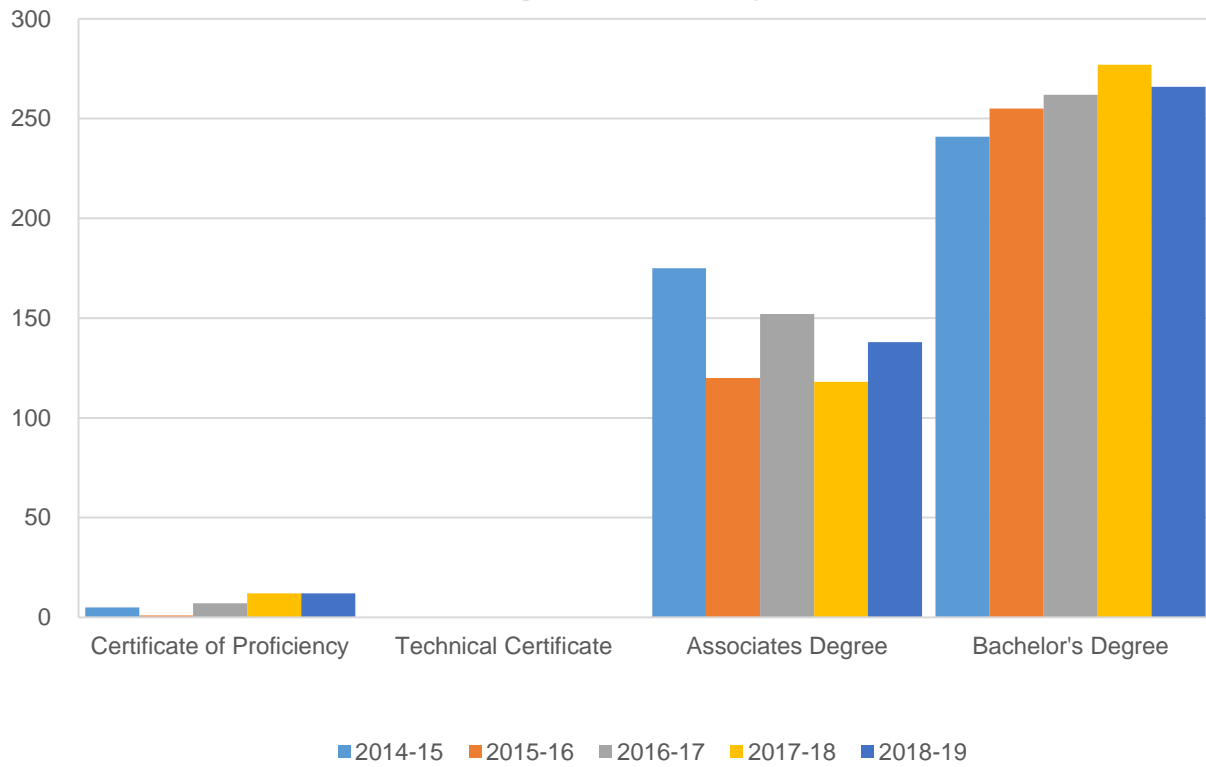

Certificates/Degrees Awarded by Level and Year**



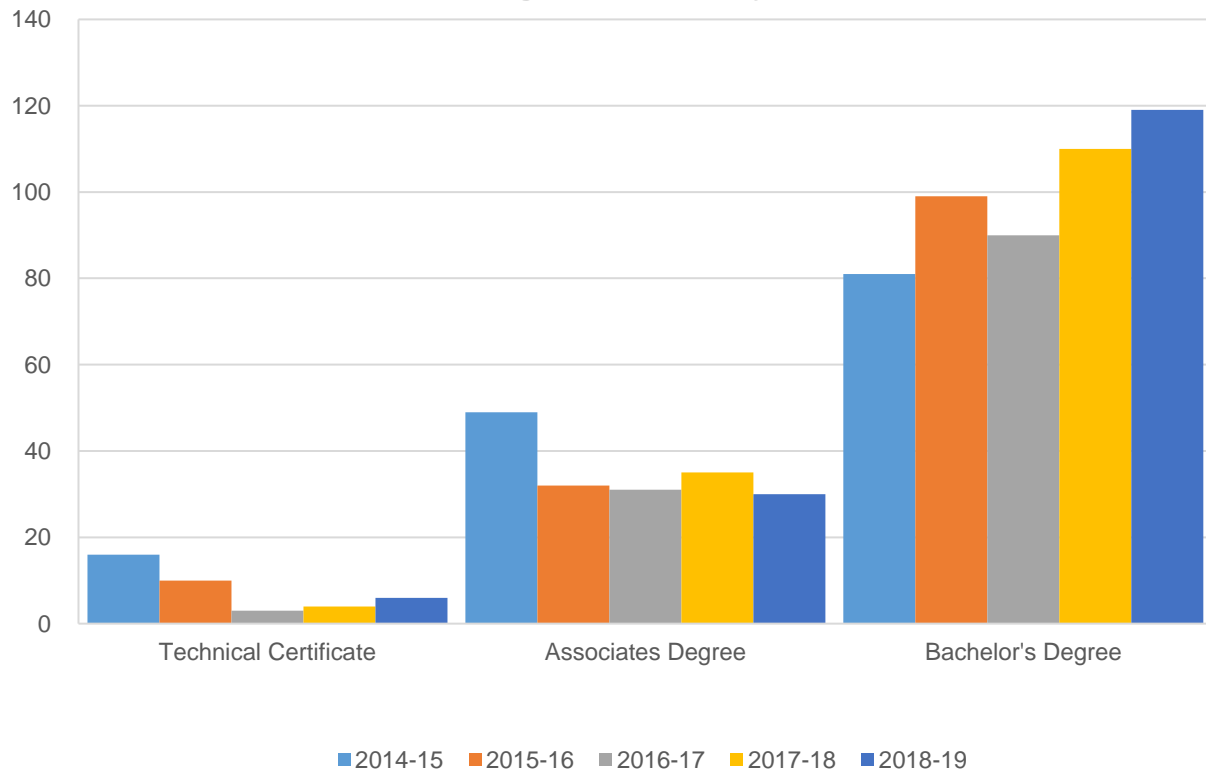
**College of Business  
Certificates/Degrees Awarded by Level and Year**



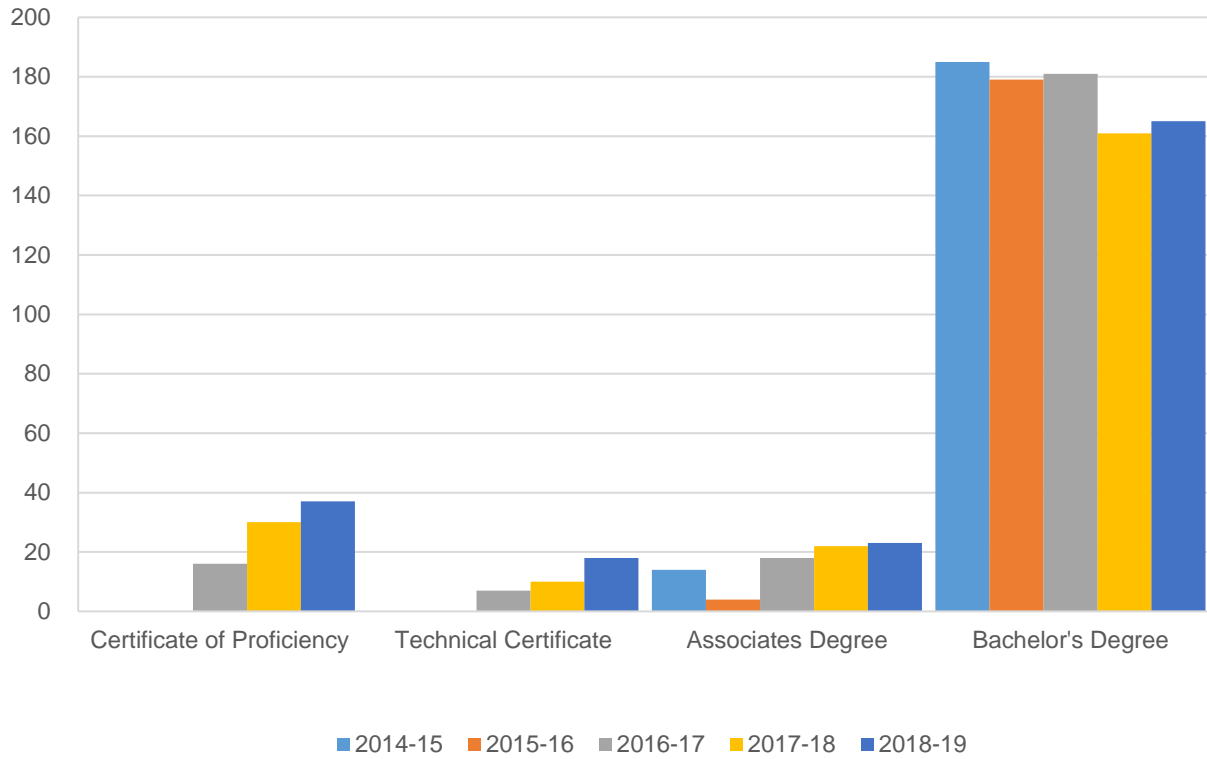
### Communication, Language Arts, Social Sciences Certificates/Degrees Awarded by Level and Year



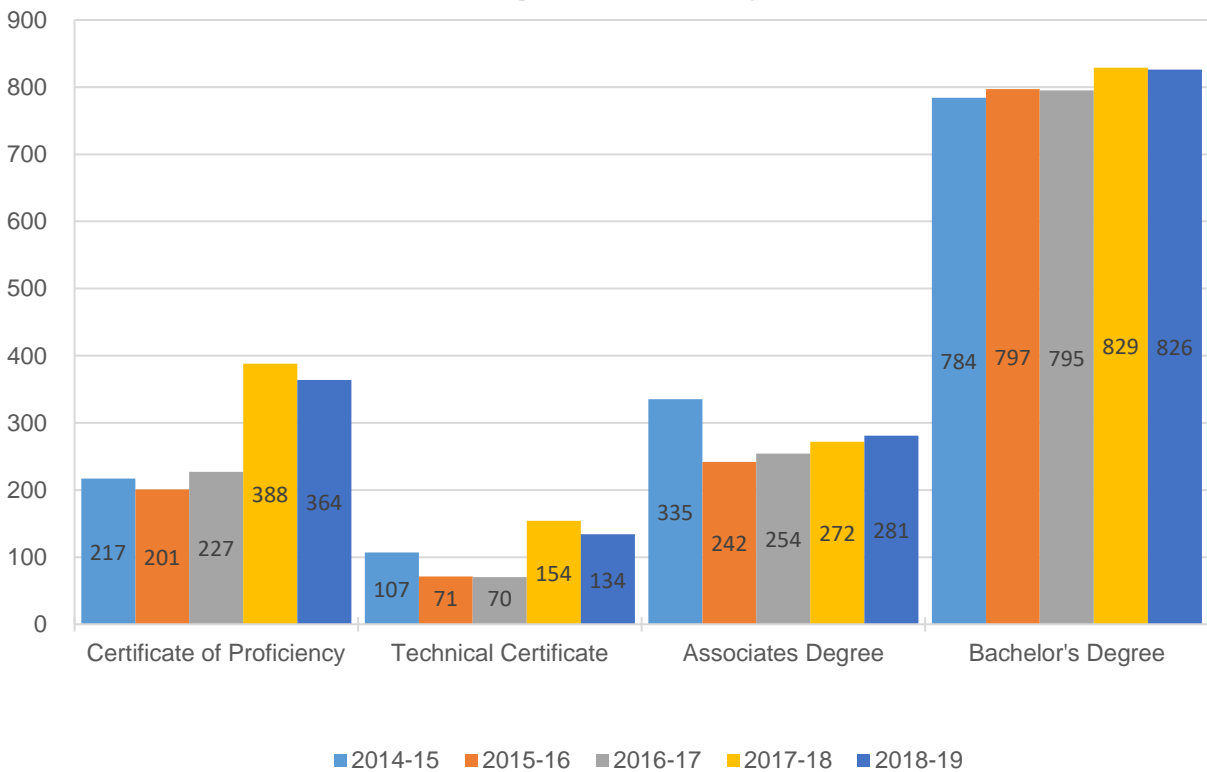
### College of Health Sciences Certificates/Degrees Awarded by Level and Year

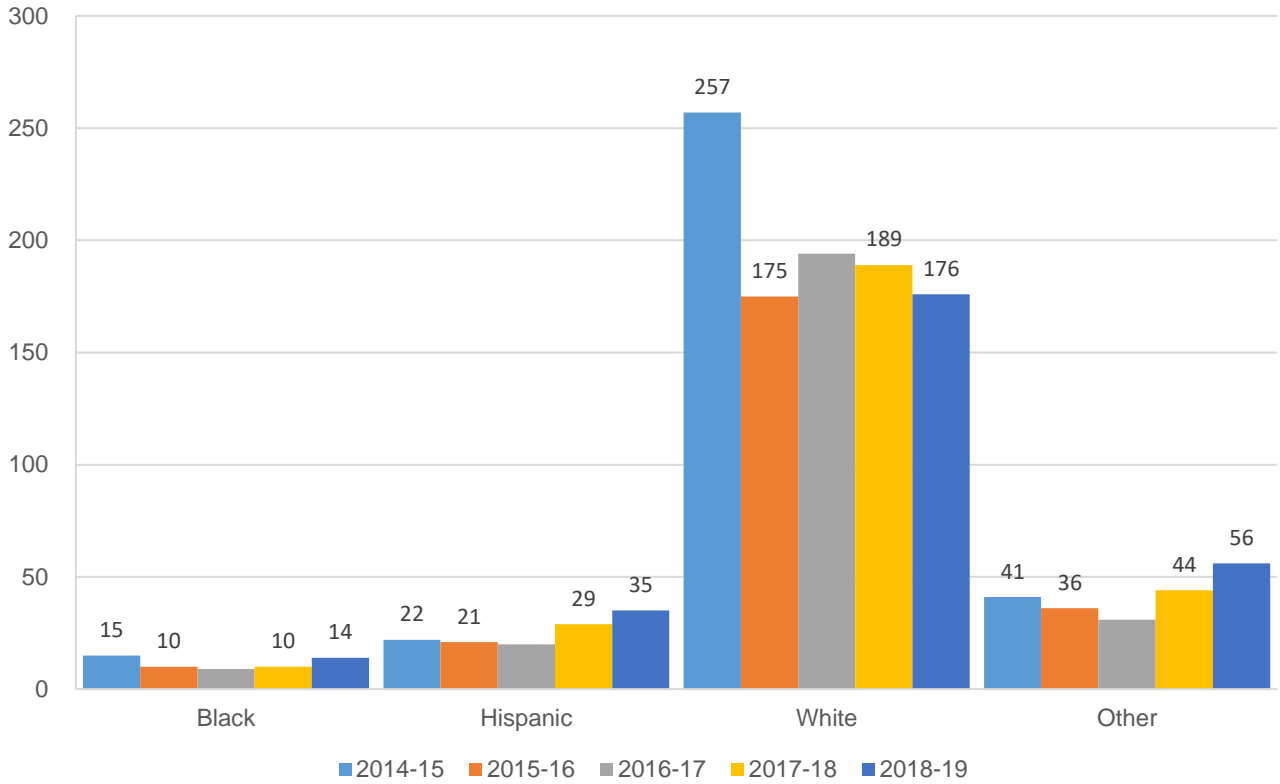

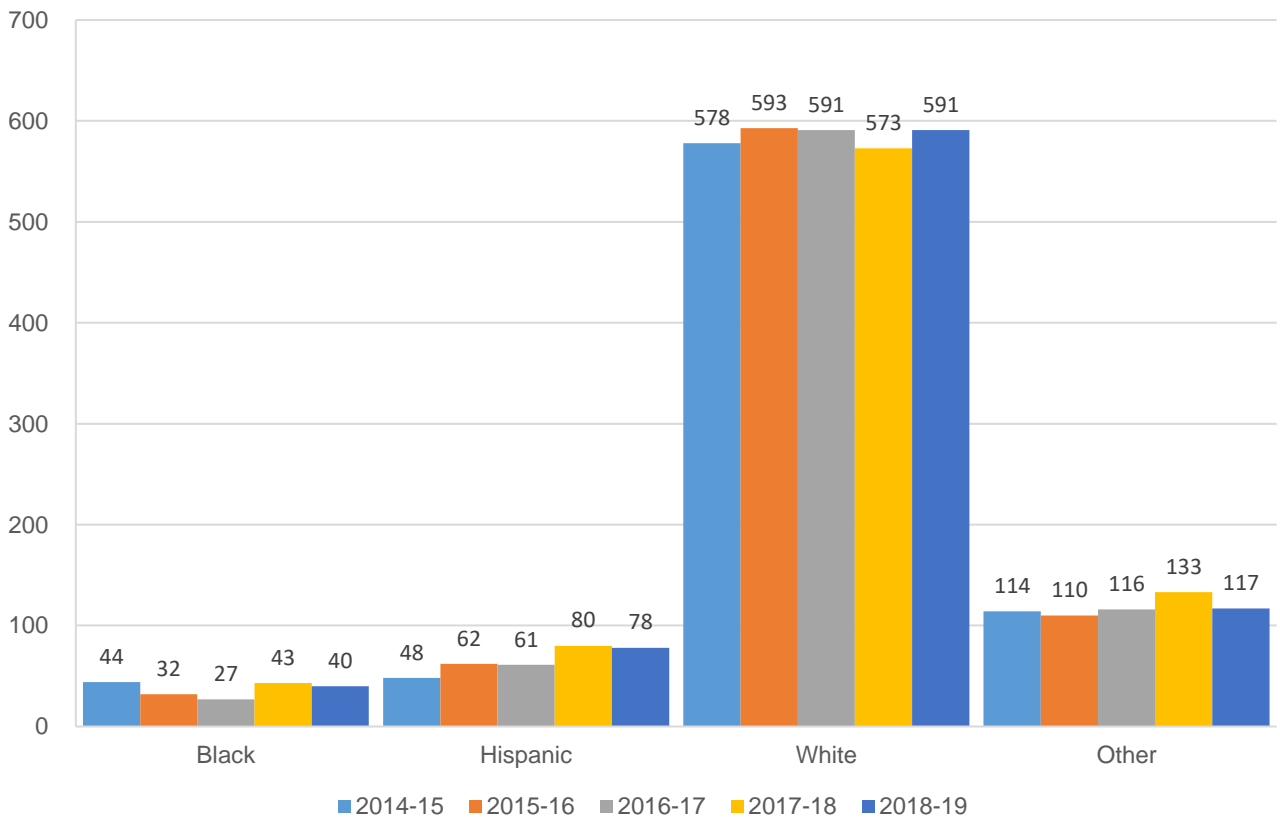

Associate Degrees Awarded by Race/Ethnicity



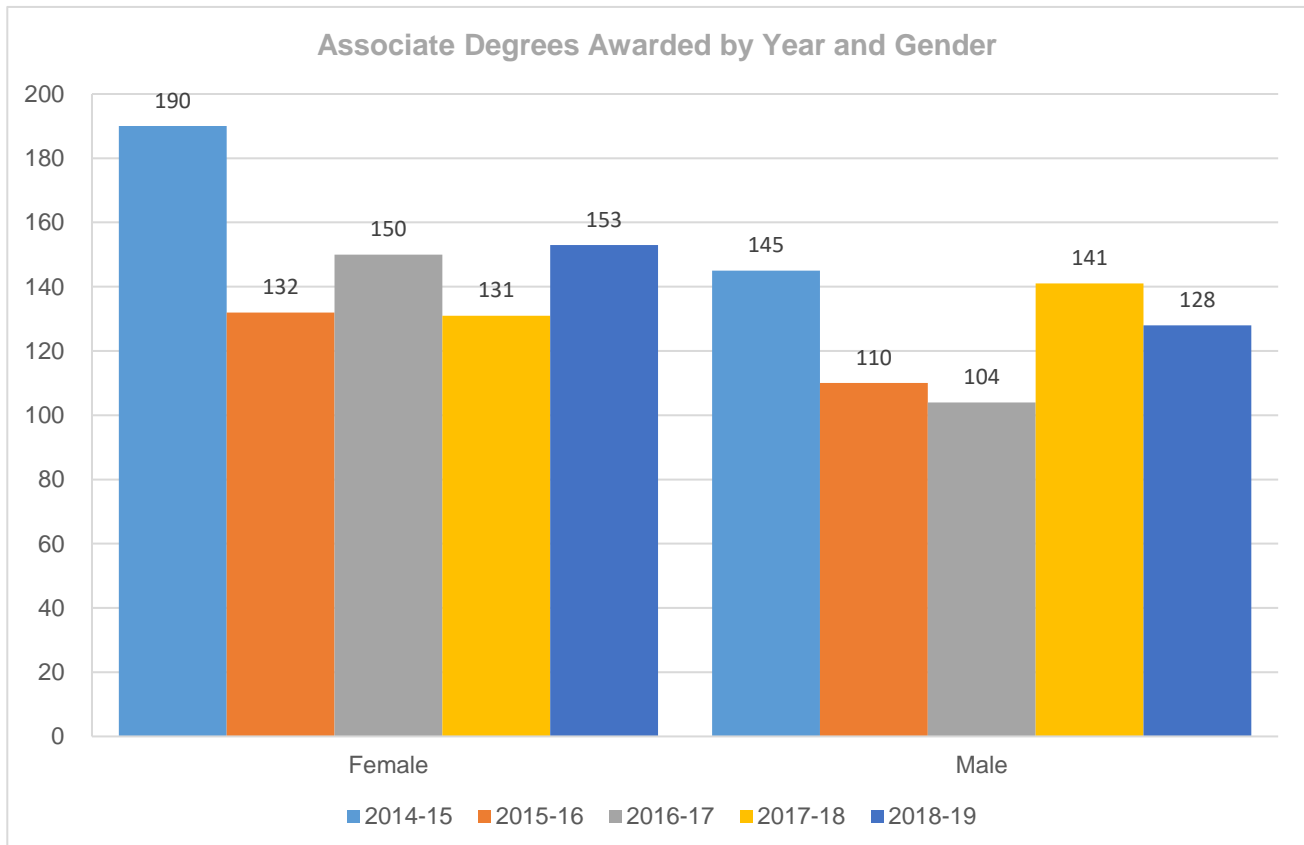
Bachelors Degrees Awarded by Year and Race/Ethnicity
